Hillsborough Community College Brandon Campus Offers Free Manufacturing Production Worker Training

Tampa – Hillsborough Community College (HCC) is seeking applicants for its first offering of a free manufacturing production worker training program leading to a national certification. Classes will be held from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., June 5 through 22, on the HCC Brandon Campus located at 10414 East Columbus Drive in Tampa.

Funded by a Workforce Florida grant and developed by HCC's Employ Florida Banner Center for Manufacturing, the 90-hour training is limited to 30 students. The program provides instruction in manufacturing production and process; safety; quality and continuous improvement; maintenance awareness; and employability skills. Training, textbooks and other training materials will be provided free of charge.

The program prepares the student with the skills and knowledge to enter the advanced manufacturing field as an entry-level production technician and take the Manufacturing Skill Standards (MSSC) Council Production Technician Certification examination. Salaries for entry-level manufacturing technicians are approximately \$30,000 per year and manufacturers are looking for skilled employees.

Along with providing free training, the Banner Center for Manufacturing will also pay the registration and test fees for those students successfully completing the training and wishing to take the national MSSC certification examination.

Applicants for the program may include employed and/or unemployed manufacturing technicians with up to one year of experience, underemployed and/or unemployed people seeking a career in manufacturing, and high school graduates seeking a career in manufacturing. A GED or high school diploma is required and high-school level reading skills are recommended.
